The Ontario GeoPortal is an integral information system for IO, providing a “one window view” to a rich but complex real estate portfolio. The Ontario GeoPortal started in 2004 as an on-premises information service. In 2010 it was moved into a commercial cloud service with over 1,200 IO and Ontario Public Service (OPS) users. It has since grown to over 2,800 users and has also grown in capabilities providing more data, more functionality, and more business solutions.

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## SOLUTION

Ontario GeoPortal empowers users to easily access, analyze, and understand the one of Canada's largest government's real estate portfolios. It uses maps to integrate associated documents and tabular datasets within SKE's GeoPortal service. Maps add “place” to the users understanding of their data. GeoPortal provides the mapping platform along with the ability to share and collaborate within and across organizations, including within IO; with the Ministry of Infrastructure (MOI), IO's parent ministry; with 29 different OPS ministries; and, with Hydro One Networks Inc. This sharing of content provides a “one-window view” to all data enabling a common understanding. Key business solutions include:

- IO Customer Portal for sharing IO's asset, facility, and leasing information with 29 different ministry facility management clients;
- Realty Circulation Portal System for circulating no-longer-needed realty assets across different levels of the public sector.
- Mines GeoPortal for mineral claims staking and title verification.
- Service Tracking System for IO's professional services delivery.
- Virtual Geomatics for IO Geomatics high-end desktop mapping and analysis services.
- Public Facing Provincial Real Estate Inventory enabling IO to publicly share the Provincial Real Estate Inventory.
- Support for Carillon lands; tax re-assessments of GREP lands; space options analysis; and many other IO programs.
